He has been a consulting ophthalmologist for the New Mexico School for the Blind and the Primate Research Institute at Holloman AFB, New Mexico. He has been associated with the RHEM since its beginning, and was chairman of the Allied Health Personnel in 1990-1991. He has performed over 1000 charity cataract surgeries in Mexico.
